House Wine

Vista Point (California) Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, White Zinfandel 5/20

White Wines

Alto Vineyards, Shawnee Gold (Alto Pass, Illinois) 7/28

Sweet Riesling, German-style wine made with vidal blanc grapes, giving it pear and pineapple aromas and flavors.

Chateau St. Jean, Chardonnay 2010 (Sonoma County, California) 8/32

Displays bright aromas of lemon cream, mango and notes of toasted hazelnut.

Blufeld, Riesling 2010 (Mosel, Germany) 7/28

Semi-sweet, crisp and refreshing with aromas of citrus, peach and floral notes.

Robert Mondavi Private Selection, Pinot Grigio 2010 (Sonoma County, California) 7/28

Bright citrus, pear and tropical fruit flavors that end with a crisp finish.

Santa Margherita, Pinot Grigio 2010 (Italy)

10/40

A fresh, clean fragrance, followed with a crisp, refreshing citrus blend that rolls on the palate.

Lotto, Moscato (Australia) 6/24

There's something about the sweet, creamy, easy-drinking style that just makes you feel lucky.

Oliver, Camelot Mead 2010 (Bloomington, Indiana) 5/20

Mead was a symbol of camaraderie among the Knights of the Round Table. A light wine, made from real honey, Camelot Mead is a revival of this historic libation.

Two Oceans, Sauvignon Blanc 2010 (Western Cape, South Africa) 6/24

Crisp, elegant, and refreshing with hints of green fig and gooseberry. Thirst quenching!

Red Wines

The Middle Sister, Forever Cool Merlot (California) 7/28

Aromas of ripe berries and vanilla with lush berries leading into a lingering cocoa powder finish.

Trapiche, Oak Cask Malbec 2010 (Mendoza, Argentina) 7/28

Aged for 12 months in oak barrels, adds finesse and harmony to the sweet aromas of blackberries

and plums with an elegant touch of smoke and vanilla, ends with a sweet and long aftertaste.

Robert Mondavi Private Selection, Pinot Noir 2010 (Sonoma County, California) 7/28

Unfolds in elegant, silky layers of wild cherries, berries and aromatic spices with warm oak nuances lingering in the finish.

Folie a Deux, Menage a Trois 2010 (Napa County, California) 7/28

A blend of zinfandel, merlot and cabernet sauvignon with a dark rich berry flavor, a hint of pepper and a lingering finish.

The Spanish Quarter, Cabernet Sauvignon-Tempranillo 2008 (Spain) 7/28

Exotic, yet familiar, this full, silky red blend marries cherry and blackberry flavors with spice and a hint of oak.

Alto Vineyards, Porto Di Guido 2007 (Alto pass, Illinois) 7/28

Made with the ripest and finest chambourcin grapes, then wood aged for eight months to produce a smooth, yet rich and distinctive port with chocolate and cherry hints.

14 Hands, Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 (Paterson, Washington) 8/32

Rich and flavorful chock-full of black currant and dark cherry characteristics. A beautiful ruby

color and is medium to full bodied.

Blush Wines
